Admission Requirements:

- Completed application for admission
- Valid RN license
- Official transcripts of all undergraduate academic work; graduate transcripts are required for a post master's program
- Bachelor of Science and/or Master of Science degree(s) (depending on chosen program).
- RNs with non-nursing bachelor's degree may apply to the MSN by meeting all of the admission criteria in this section with the exception of the BSN. Additionally, you would be required to complete the following courses prior to beginning MSN courses:
 - NRP 477 Leadership in Nursing
 - NRP 472 - Nursing Research or an equivalent undergraduate research course
 - Either NRP 475 Population Centered Health in the Community or 473 Quality Care for Vulnerable Populations
 - Add HIN 355 Foundations of Health Informatics
- Minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0
- Undergraduate course in statistics with a grade of C or better for the MSN program
